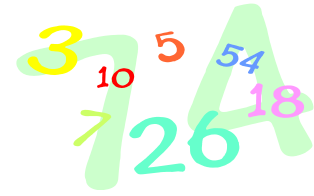

Bug Club - 3 sessions per week.

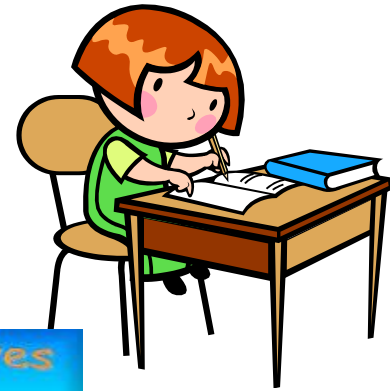
Reading at home 15 mins at least 3 times a week.

Reading book home for some with the rest of the class being assigned a book online.

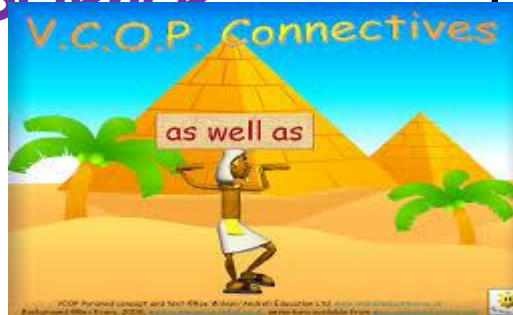
