<p><b>Creative Letters</b> Write your words by cutting out letters from old newspapers and magazines and stick them on to paper.</p>	<p><b>Play Doh</b> Make your spelling words using Play Doh.</p>	<p><b>Air Write</b> Write your words in the air with large arm movements.</p>	<p><b>Hangman</b> Play Hangman with a parent or carer using your spelling words.</p>	<p><b>Big Writing</b> Write your spelling words as big as you can.</p>
<p><b>Chalk Spelling</b> Write your spelling words in chalk on your driveway or a paved area in your garden.</p>	<p><b>Crayon Spelling</b> Write your words in crayon. How many colours can you use?</p>	<p><b>Felt tip pen Spelling</b> Write your words in felt tip pen. How many colours can you use?</p>	<p><b>Paint your Words</b> Use paint to paint your words on a piece of paper. Paint a picture of one of your words too!</p>	<p><b>Finger Tracing</b> Use your finger to spell out each of your spelling words, one letter at a time on your parent or carers back. Can they guess the word? Get them to do the same to you!</p>
<p><b>Messy Spelling</b> Put some icing sugar or shaving foam on a tray, write your words in the sugar or foam.</p>	<p><b>Delicious Spelling</b> Write your spelling words in something tasty e.g. jam, honey, peanut butter!</p>	<p><b>Pasta Words</b> Make your spelling words using pasta.</p>	<p><b>Torch Spelling</b> In a darkened room, use a torch to write your words in the air.</p>	<p><b>Picture Words</b> Draw a picture of one of your words. Write your spelling word around the picture.</p>
<p><b>Speedy Spell</b> Set a timer for 30 seconds, how many times can you write one of your spelling words?</p>	<p><b>Sentences</b> Write a sentence for 3 of your spelling words. Underline your spelling word in each sentence.</p>	<p><b>Practice Test</b> Ask a parent or carer to do a mock spelling test with you.</p>	<p><b>Spelling City</b> Use Spelling City to practise your spelling.
