How many colours can you use?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Rhyming Words</p> <p>Make a list of words that rhyme with each of your spelling words. How many can you find?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Finger Tracing</p> <p>Use your finger to spell out each of your spelling words, one letter at a time on your parent or carers back. Can they guess the word? Get them to do the same to you!</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Stencil Words</p> <p>Find an alphabet stencil and use it to practise your spelling words.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Capital Letters</p> <p>Write your words in capital letters.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Connect the Dots</p> <p>Write your spelling words in dots then connect the dots by tracing over them in a coloured pencil or pen.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Alphabetical Order</p> <p>Write your words in alphabetical order.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Speedy Spell</p> <p>Set a timer for 30 seconds, how many times can you write one of your spelling words?</p>

Underline your spelling word in each sentence.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Sentences</p> <p>Write a sentence for 5 of your spelling words.
