Play it with a parent, carer or friend.	<b>Parts of Speech</b> Sort your words into parts of speech groups eg nouns, verbs, adjectives etc
<b>Newspaper Headlines</b> Make headlines for a newspaper using some or all of your words.	<b>5 clues!</b> Write five clues for five of your words without using the word in the clue. For example, gigantic. 1. What we call a very big item.    2. Humongous    3. The opposite of tiny    4. An elephant, for example 5. An adjective Give the clues to a parent, carer or friend. Can they work out the words.			
<b>Mnemonics</b> Choose a word you are finding tricky to learn. Create a mnemonic for it. Eg because Big Elephants Can Always Upset Small Elephants	<b>Word search Words</b> Create a word search using your spelling words. Bring it in for a friend to do.	<b>Word Definitions</b> Write the definitions for 9 of your spelling words.	<b>Short Story Words</b> Write a short story using your spelling words. Can you use them all? Underline your spelling words.	<b>Speedy Spell</b> Set a timer for 30 seconds, how many times can you write one of your spelling words?
<b>Silly Sentences</b> Write a silly sentence for 9 of your spelling words. Underline your spelling word in each sentence.	<b>Sentences</b> Write a sentence for 9 of your spelling words. Underline your spelling word in each sentence.	<b>Practice Test</b> Ask a parent or carer to do a mock spelling test with you.	<b>Spelling City</b> Use Spelling City to practise your spelling.
