
Social Studies Topic

Class 1 have all showed an interest in animals. As a result of this, Class 1 have decided to begin the new topic of Pets this term. This will be planned in consultation with the children to ensure enjoyment and choice. Through this topic we will explore the most common household pets, their different characteristics and how to look after them.









<u>Maths</u>

In Class 1, we have been focussing on revision of previous learning. The boys and girls have been revising numbers 1-20, addition to 10 and shape. The children have enjoyed revisiting their learning through play and fun, interactive activities. The class really enjoy using the interactive whiteboard to play math games together.

Some groups in the class have been practising number formation and the ordering of numbers from 1-10. The class are all showing great progress in both interactive and written tasks. Great work Class 1!

Literacy

The boys and girls have been revising their initial sounds and phonics and have also revisited some CVC spelling words. The pupils have enjoyed reading their reading books in class and story time is always something that the children look forward to. The class also all enjoy talking about their weekends and sharing it with the class during writing sessions.

Some groups of pupils have been practising their letter formations and fine motor skills such as pencil control.

Health and Wellbeing

In Class 1 we have been focussing on emotions and expressing our feelings. We have centred our work around the book, "The Colour Monster". As a class we have been able to identify different feelings and what may cause us to feel a certain way. The class enjoyed creating their own Mood Monster to express how they were feeling.

We have also enjoyed reading the book "Have You Filled a Bucket Today?". The book focusses on showing kindness to others. The class are working hard at being "Bucket Fillers" in the classroom. The boys and girls enjoyed making their own buckets and
